RIO 2016 OLYMPIC PARK COMPETITION

The **RIO 2016 OLYMPIC PARK** is located in one of the four Olympic centers scheduled for development of the 2016 Games, and concentrates the greatest number of sporting equipment and installations. It is a fundamental space for the development of the Olympic Games and for the vitality of Rio de Janeiro. To participate in the Competition it is mandatory the assembly or constitution of a multidisciplinary Minimum Team , coordinated by an architect or urban planner, legally accredited, in Brazil or abroad. *Read more*.
