


During 3 days, over 1,500 participants gathered in Oslo, Norway, to participate in a world congress on landscape architecture; IFLA 2019 Common Ground.








THE CONGRESS WAS FULLY BOOKED WITH ALMOST 1,000 EARLY BIRDS


