

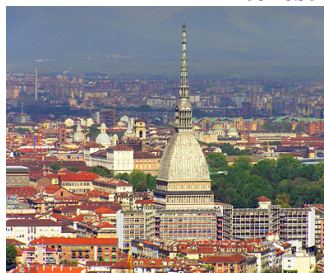
Technical Visit and Commissioners Meeting

Turin, Italy

28th and 29th May 2011



Our IFPRA members in Turin, Luigi Delloste (Technician of the Park and Garden Department of Turin and delegate of the A.I.D.T.P.G.) and Gabriele Schetter (consultant and member of A.I.D.T.P.G.), have made arrangements for Ifpra members and other participants for a most interesting weekend visit to their important parks and gardens.



- Turin has the reputation of being one of the greenest cities in Europe, boasting some 25 parks.
- As well as shady piazzas, tree-lined boulevards, small gardens and public parks.
- These include the historic Parco del Valentino and the Pellerina, reputed to be the largest city park in Italy.
Many of Turin's parks and gardens are located along the banks of the four rivers that run through the city, offering a place in which to enjoy peace and quiet.
- Visitors can also admire some 85 different tree species that line park avenues and the city's boulevards.

The programme commences on the 28th May with a meeting of Commissioners of IFPRA Europe followed by lunch, a technical visit in the afternoon and an evening dinner.

The following day (29th) there will be a technical visit from 8.30 to 15.00 (including lunch)

Recommended Hotel - Hotel Genio, Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, Torino.

- The centrally located hotel is only 100 m from the Central Railway Station Porta Nuova
- In front of the station is the bus to the airport Caselle and the underground to reach the railway station Porta Susa

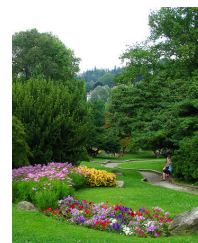
Costs of the rooms per night - €85 single room, €115 double room, Parking costs 12-15 Euro/day

29th May - 8.30 to 15.00 - Technical Visit

- This will entail travelling by bus to visit a number of important historic parks in and around Turin.
- The visit will terminate with a late lunch at 15.00 and there will be tea/coffee breaks in between.
- The programme is designed to facilitate participants who wish to return home on Sunday evening.



The itinerary will include the following parks:

- **Gardens of the Castle Venaria Reale:** Both the castle and gardens are undergoing renovation
- **Parco della Pellerina:** Turin's greatest park with 837.220qm.
- **Parco della Tesoriera:** storical park, amplified in the 19th century.
- **Parco del Valentino:** most famous and oldest public park with remarkable trees, flowerbeds and a rock garden.
